| <p>1. Purpose<br/>Title 22<br/>Sec. 4.13<br/>SC 801, 803</p> | <p>The Board shall provide instructional and evaluative materials to implement and support the district's and the schools' educational goals and academic standards.</p>  |
| <p>2. Definition</p>   | <p><b>Resource materials</b> shall include reference books, supplementary titles, multimedia materials, maps, library books, software and instructional material.</p>   |
| <p>3. Delegation of Responsibility<br/>SC 803</p>            | <p>The Superintendent, after consultation with the teaching staff, shall be responsible for the selection, recommendation, and maintenance of all resource materials. No adoption or change of materials shall be made without his or her recommendation, except by a two-thirds vote of the Board.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop and implement selection procedures for resource materials.</p>  |
| <p>4. Guidelines</p>   | <p>Selection procedures shall be developed that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Appoint appropriate administrative and instructional staff to select resource materials, and inform the Superintendent of their choices.</li> <li>2. Ensure that the Board's budgetary allotment for resource materials is spent efficiently and distributed prudently throughout the instructional program.</li> <li>3. Ensure an inventory of resource materials that is well-balanced and well-rounded in coverage of subject, types of materials, and variety of content.</li> <li>4. Evaluate the effectiveness of resource materials presently in use.</li> <li>5. Direct staff to consult a variety of media sources before selections are made.</li> </ol> |
