

Graduation Project Timeline



All dates apply to your junior year!

- * **September:** - You will receive information in your English class about the graduation project. You will **select a teacher** from the committee to be your project advisor.
- * **By October 31-** You will **choose your topic** and type of project and "run it by" your adviser.
- * **November-** You will **meet formally** with your advisor to review your project proposal and begin to complete the proposal form.
- * **Before winter break-** You will **submit a proposal form** with a parent or guardian signature to your advisor for approval. The proposal must outline your project and include a timeline for completion.
- * **March** - You will **meet formally** with your advisor to discuss your project progress and the timeline for meeting your goals.
- * **Late May/early June** - You will **present** your project before a panel that may consist of: your advisor, other committee members, other teachers, principals, administrators, board members, and parents.

Keep up!! Failure to meet these important target dates may result in scoring penalties, parent notification, withholding of report card, and denial of entry to school-related activities.

Failure to complete a project will prevent you from graduating!
