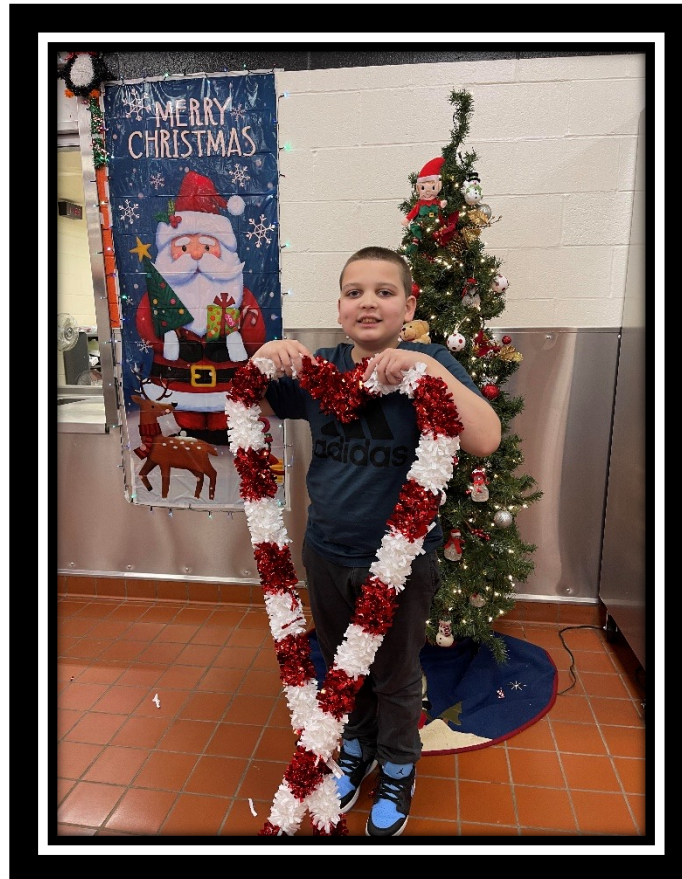
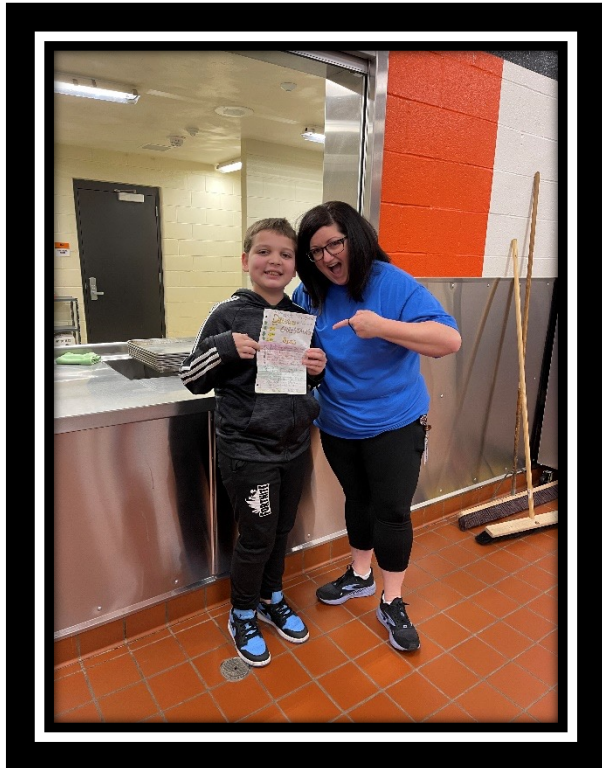
As we wind down 2023 and look forward to 2024, we reflect on our appreciation of our staff and all of our customers!

TNG On-Site at WAES

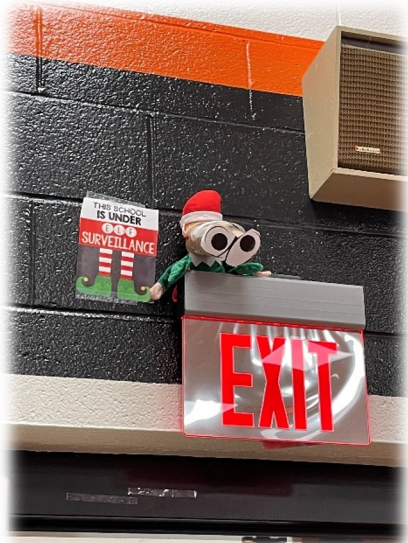


Santa Visited the elementary school during breakfast on December 19th

- Customer Experience



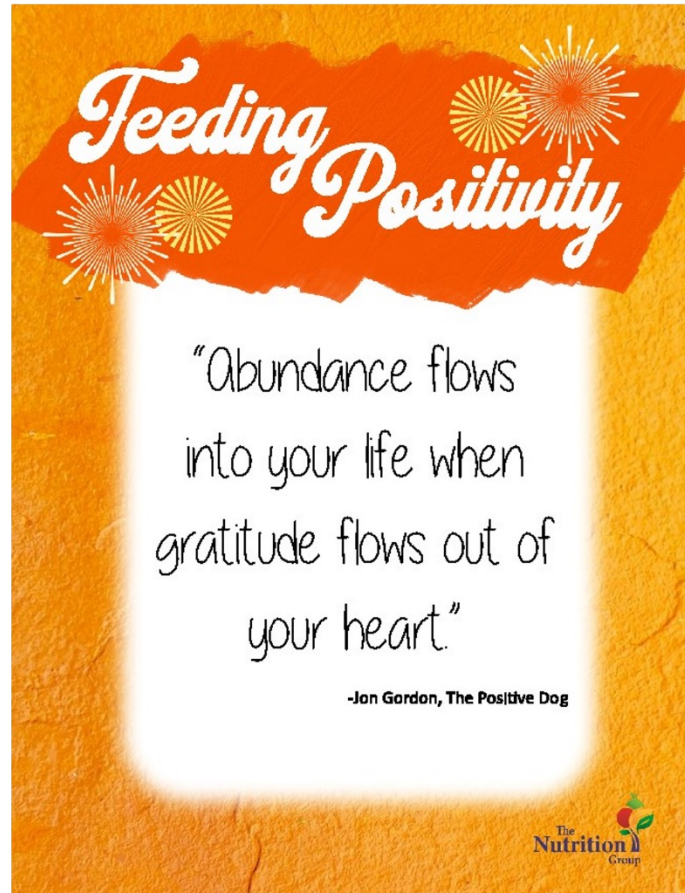
Feeding Positivity
